

**CITY OF HASKELL
ORDINANCE 20-2024**

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE REVISED WARD BOUNDARIES TO EQUALIZE
WARD POPULATIONS AFTER THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES
INTO THE CITY OF HASKELL AND TO AMEND ORDINANCE Nos. 02-2002

WHEREAS, under Ark. Code Ann. 14-43-311, it is the duty of the City Council to see that each ward has as nearly an equal population as would best serve the interest of the people of the City; and

WHEREAS, under prevailing law, cities are required to revise ward boundaries to maintain substantially equal population in all wards: and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 10-2024 after a vote of the City Council annexed certain real property into the city limits of Haskell causing a need for redistricting of certain wards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Haskell has proposed new ward boundaries which substantially equalize each ward's population.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1. Boundary Revisions

The Haskell City Council hereby approves the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" as the new ward boundary map for Haskell which establishes substantially equal populations for each ward and amends Ordinance Nos. 02-2002 by adopting the new ward boundary map to replace all previous ward boundaries and boundary maps.

SECTION 2. General Repealer

All ordinances, resolutions, and parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: Severability

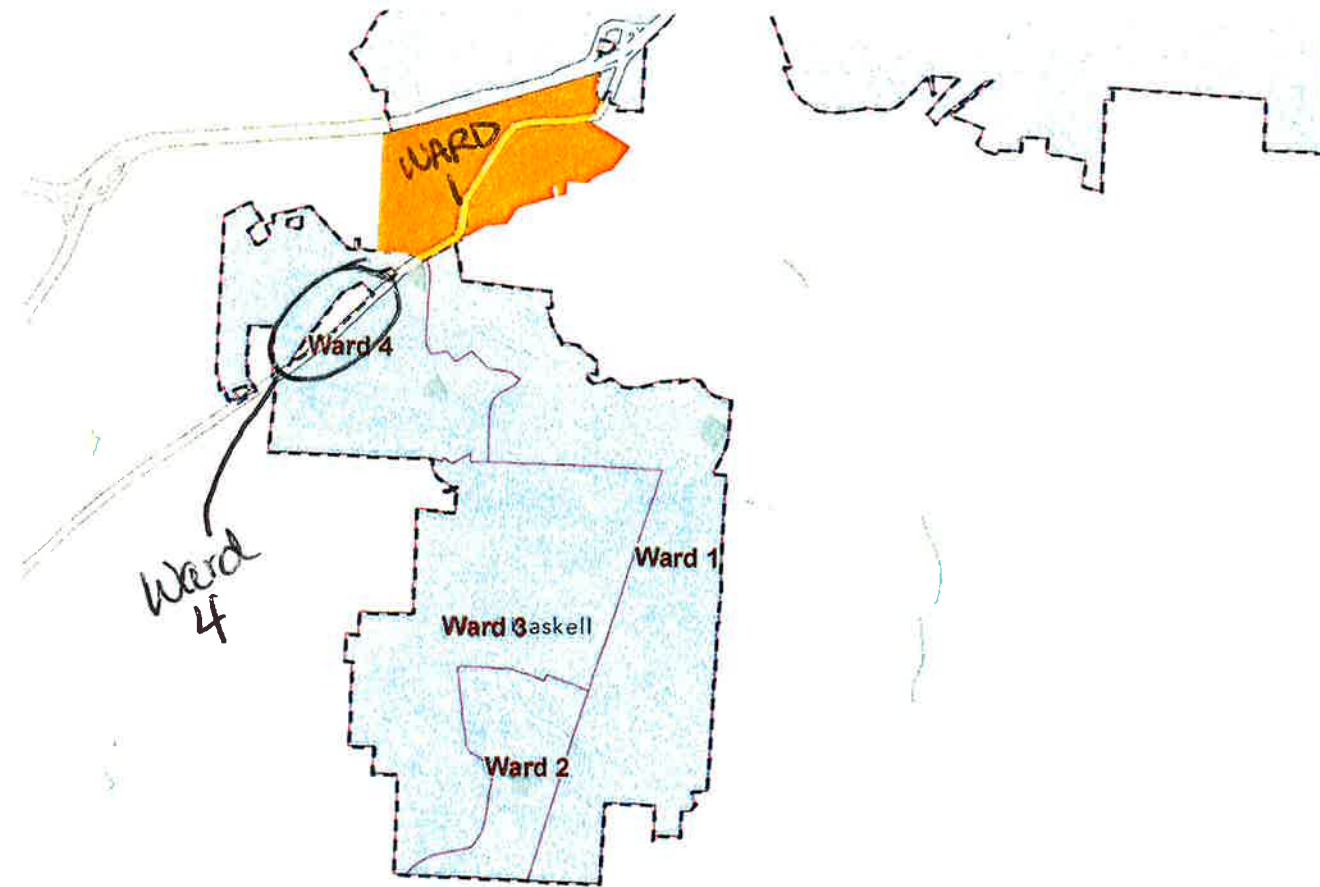
