

**CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS
RESOLUTION NO. 10-2026**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION AND SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY,
INCLUDING SCRAP METAL FROM THE CITY'S SEWER FACILITIES AND OBSOLETE
COMPUTER EQUIPMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Haskell, Arkansas, owns certain personal property consisting of scrap metal located at its sewer plants, which is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City also owns certain computer equipment and related electronic devices that have become obsolete, outdated, or nonfunctional and are no longer useful for City operations; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas law, including but not limited to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-54-302, authorizes municipalities to sell and dispose of personal property that is no longer needed for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to declare such property as surplus and authorize its sale or disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1.

The following property is hereby declared surplus and no longer needed for municipal purposes:

- (a) Scrap metal located at the City's sewer plants; and
- (b) Obsolete, outdated, or nonfunctional computer equipment and electronic devices.

SECTION 2.

The Mayor and/or their designee is hereby authorized to sell the scrap metal for the best obtainable price, including sale to a scrap dealer or through other lawful means deemed appropriate.

SECTION 3.

The Mayor and/or their designee is authorized to dispose of obsolete computer equipment in a manner consistent with applicable law, including sale, recycling, or proper disposal. Any data-containing devices shall be wiped or destroyed in accordance with reasonable data security practices prior to disposition.

SECTION 4.

All proceeds from the sale of such property shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund.
