

RESOLUTION NO. 19-2026

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT, AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS, TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY; AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Haskell, Arkansas, owns certain vehicles, equipment, and personal property that are no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that such property is obsolete, worn, excess to the City's needs, or otherwise unsuitable for continued municipal use; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas law authorizes municipalities to sell and dispose of surplus personal property upon approval of the governing body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Surplus Property.

The City Council hereby declares the following vehicles and equipment to be surplus property and authorizes their disposal in the manner set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Sale of Former Police Vehicles.

Because the former police vehicles may contain emergency lighting, sirens, or other law enforcement equipment, the Mayor is authorized to offer such vehicles for sale exclusively to federal, state, county, municipal, or other governmental entities for a period deemed reasonable by the Mayor.

Should no governmental entity purchase one or more of the vehicles, the Mayor is authorized to remove or cause the removal of any emergency equipment as required by law and thereafter sell the vehicles through GovDeals.com or another commercially reasonable method of sale determined to be in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 3. Sale of Other Surplus Property.

The Mayor is authorized to sell the remaining surplus vehicles and equipment identified herein through sealed bids. The Mayor shall establish reasonable bid procedures and reserves the right to reject any and all bids when determined to be in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 4. Authority to Execute Documents.

The Mayor and City Recorder/Treasurer are authorized to execute any bills of sale, titles, transfer documents, and other instruments necessary to complete the sale and disposition of the surplus property described herein.

SECTION 5. Repealer.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
