

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2026

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS FOR STREET PAVING SERVICES; ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FROM REDSTONE CONSTRUCTION GROUP; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Haskell, Arkansas, has determined that there is a critical need for street paving, resurfacing, and improvements on Inverness Cove and Sahalee Cove within Haskell, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas law, specifically Arkansas Code § 14-58-303 for cities, provides that the governing body may by resolution waive the requirements of competitive bidding in exceptional situations where this procedure is deemed not feasible or practical; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has evaluated the paving proposal submitted by Redstone Construction Group and has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to forgo the formal, often lengthy competitive bid process in order to utilize this contractor already on a state cooperative contract and to meet the needs of our community; and

WHEREAS, Redstone Construction Group has submitted a proposal for the specified street paving work dated 7/9/26, attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution, for a total estimated cost of \$66,170.50 or at a rate of \$139.50 per installed ton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the governing body hereby finds and determines that an exceptional situation exists making the formal competitive bidding procedure for street paving not feasible or practical, and hereby waives the competitive bidding requirements as authorized by Arkansas law.

SECTION 2. That the quote/proposal submitted by Redstone Construction Group for paving and improvement services on designated streets is hereby accepted.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute the contract/agreement with Redstone Construction Group for the performance of the paving project using funds appropriated from the Street Fund.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
